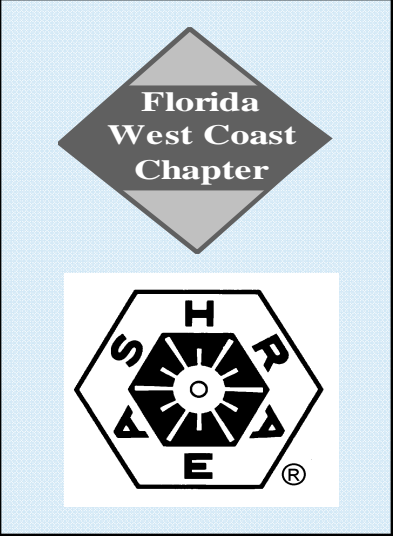
She has also assisted in the development of the commissioning program for state government buildings in Louisiana.

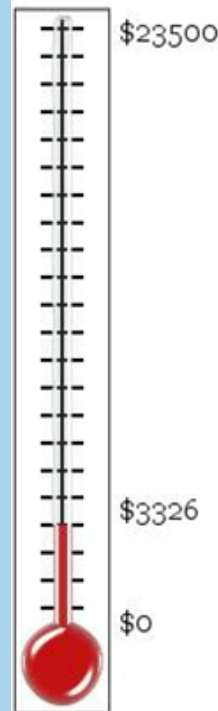

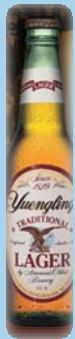

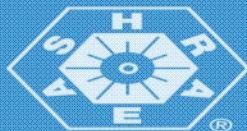
